Last month CFAM Pakistan Chairman Zafar Iqbal called the team together to organize visits to distribute Holy Bibles to Brick Kilns workers, where the team has been working recently. The team was able to distribute Bibles on Friday September 18, 2020. Sunday School Reopening

CFAM Pakistan Chairman Zafar Iqbal convened a meeting in which the reopening of Sunday schools was discussed. It was decided that on 20th of September, 2020 the team would go to Shiekhupura to reopen Sunday school activities as per Government of Pakistan Covid-19 SOP’s (Mask, Social Distancing, Hand washing/ Hand sanitizing). To travel there the team arranged to meet at Patherwali District Nankana sahib. Due to a recent incident on a highway our team was traveling where a mother was raped and her

two children beaten coordinator Waseem requested the CFAM team to arrange safe transport for the teachers. By the grace of God our team was able to travel safely and reached our destination at noon.

To keep the teachers and students safe in this time of COVID CFAM team arranged the necessary items:

1. Face masks
2. Hand sanitizers
3. Refreshments

REOPENING OF SCHOOLS:

After prayer and introductions, teachers were given instructions

and demonstrations on how to hand sanitize and wear masks. They were also taught how to help their students with hand sanitizer and masks and socially distance when they were sitting. Teachers were instructed to strictly monitor student attendance and record numbers of students.

CFAM makes sure all children will be safe during this pandemic. We are so thankful to the parents of the children who were able to send their children so they can continue learning about the Word of God.
